Think of it as a grammar primer, if you will, that will instruct you on a large number of topics including: semicolons, possessive apostrophes, parts of speech, writing a limerick, adverbs, the Oxford comma, ending a sentence with a preposition, predicate nominatives, pronouns with implied verbs, vocabulary, and, of course, the pluperfect subjunctive. The last third of the book contains random, non-grammatically related poems on such diverse subjects as Frank Zappa, cooking with onions, solving simultaneous equations, Ohm s law, and the \$2 bill. All the poems are clever, a bit snarky, and include a zinger. Barrie Gauthier by profession is an electronics engineer. At a very early age, though, he was memorizing jingles and songs that he heard on the radio and television. At seven, he wrote his first poem, My Mother.
